
WANTED BY THE FBI

Scars and Marks: Moreno has a tattoo on his chest which reads "El More"; a tattoo of a cross

on his right hand; and a tattoo of a cross on one of his legs with the word

"Maggy".

Remarks:

Reportedly, Moreno may be an undocumented alien living illegally in the United States. He has ties to Mexico and Los Angeles, California. Additionally, Moreno may be residing in the state of Washington. A painter by trade, Moreno has painted bridges in the San Diego, California, area.

CAUTION

Lorenzo Castro Moreno is wanted for committing several crimes in San Diego, California. Moreno allegedly violated his restraining order when he visited the home of a female victim on July 17, 2001. The restraining order bound Moreno to cease all contact with the victim. Reportedly, Moreno went to the victim's home in an attempt to persuade her to rescind the restraining order. When the victim refused, Moreno allegedly retrieved a knife from the kitchen and stabbed her several times in front of her children. After the attack, Moreno allegedly threw the knife at the victim's son, barely missing him. Moreno then fled the scene.

On January 24, 2002, a state arrest warrant was issued by the Superior Court of California, County of San Diego, Central Division, charging Lorenzo Castro Moreno with attempted murder, assault with a deadly weapon/force likely to cause great bodily injury, and cruelty to a child by endangering health. Subsequently, on October 10, 2003, a federal arrest warrant was issued by the United States District Court, Southern District of California, charging Moreno with unlawful flight to avoid prosecution.
